Workshop Description:

Using a block (see above) from Nancy's *In Remembrance* quilt, which is featured in her book *El Camino Real: Quilts Inspired by Early California History*, students will work with the Wash-Away Appliqué product, hole punches, and bias bars to prepare the patches for appliqué. Nancy will share her time-saving techniques that help you avoid drawn-out hand appliqué processes without sacrificing quality stitching. Efficiently cut and address the templates, glue-baste perfect circles and sharp points in deceptively simple techniques, then machine-stitch your motif to the background for heirloom-quality results.

Heart Template (provided by instructor)

Cuticle Stick*

Purple Glue Stick*

Monofilament thread*

Paper towels

Sharp Cut-to-the-Point scissors OR Serrated Scissors

Light Box (optional)

Bias Press Bars* (Collins)

Fabric for little quilt shown above* OR bring your own fabric (1/2 yd background, asst colors for patches)
