

## Tall Ship

I must down to the seas again, to the lonely sea and the sky, And all I ask is a tall ship and a star to steer her by . . . (John Masefield, "Sea Fever")



Tall Ship Finished size: 12"

Cutting - all measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

From dark blue (sky)

A - 5 squares 2 7/8"x2 7/8"

B - 1 square 2 1/2"x2 1/2"

C - 1 rectangle 2 1/2"x4 1/2"

D - 1 " 2 1/2"x6 1/2"

E-2 " 2 1/2"x8 1/2"

From white (sails)

A - 5 squares 2 7/8"x2 7/8"

From red (ship)

F - 1 rectangle 2 1/2"x12 1/2"

From medium blue (water)

B - 2 squares 2 1/2"x2 1/2"


G - 1 rectangle 2 1/2"x12 1/2"

## Sewing -

1. With right sides together of 5 piece A dark blue sky, and 5 white sails, draw a diagonal line on lighter fabric and sew 1/4" on each side of line. Cut on diagonal line to yield 10 squares 2 1/2"x2 ½"



- 2. Assemble as per diagram:
- 3. Sew a piece B medium blue to each side of piece F red on diagonal line and trim to 1/4".
- 4. Join the pieced units, adding piece G at the bottom to complete the block.
