Please remember to bring a fat quarter in a brown paper bag, if you want to take part in the fat quarter game!

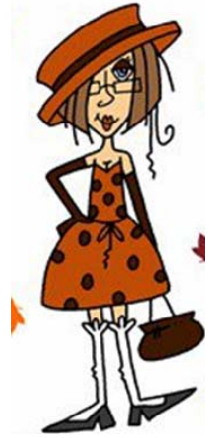

AGREEMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPLAYING QUILTS

Please read before completing and signing entry form

The Valley Quilters are sponsoring this show for the pleasure of quilters and quilt lovers all over Southern California. We invite you to enter your quilt in our show, February 7 & 8, 2014. **ALL ENTRY FORMS must be received by December 1, 2013.** We request machine and hand quilted items only. No tied quilts (except Crazy quilts). We reserve the right to refuse any quilts that we consider to be in poor taste or inappropriate for our show. You will be notified if your Entry is not accepted. Please be sure to keep a copy of your entry form.

THE OWNER OF THE QUILT AGREES TO:

Hand sew on all quilts 60" or wider a 5" sleeve below the upper back edge so a rod for hanging can be inserted. Smaller quilts will be carefully pinned to a drape. Please be sure sleeve is secure.
