May 5, 2016

Call to Order: A general membership meeting of the FQG was held at the Fallbrook Community Center in Fallbrook, Ca., on May 5th, 2016. The meeting was convened at 6:30 PM, by our presiding President Shirley Fleming, who led the Pledge of Allegiance.

President's Announcements:

- Welcome to all members, guests, and our guest speaker Claudia Dallas Gomez, and her husband.
- Minutes of the May guild and board meeting were reviewed, approved and published in the last newsletter.
- Our next board meeting will be on May 13th, 2016 at 10a.m, at the Quilter's Cottage. All members are
 welcomed and encouraged to attend, to present any ideas or concerns. Your input is both valued and
 appreciated.
- The Turnover meeting for outgoing and incoming Board and committee members will be held on June 4th, at 9:30a.m., at FPUD. All members involved are required to attend in order to make a smooth transition.
 Outgoing officers and chairs must have their procedure manuals updated and ready to turn over. We will be allowing time to visit and exchange questions and answers regarding the various roles. We will be serving coffee, tea and pastries.
- Reminder all members are welcome to submit articles for the newsletter. Our current newsletter editor is Christy Smith. She has been the editor for 2014-2015 and 2015-2016,
 And has done a fantastic job. Thank you Christy! Our new editor for 2016-2017 will be Collette Ford.
 Collette brings professional experience with newsletters for various businesses, which she brings to our fortunate guild.
- Shirley thanked all the raffle committees BOM, Cup & a Quarter, Door Prizes, and Monthly Drawing, for the outstanding job they have all done this year. They have brought in \$1919.00 so far this year, not including tonight.
- Shirley also thanked The Swap Shoppe committee, proposed by Paula Manning and her Friendship group. In just 3 months they have made \$156.00. And thanks to all that have brought in items to sell at the Swap Shoppe table.
 - She acknowledged the great job that the Boutique Committee is doing, by continuing to raise funds by selling items at the Historical Society's open air market. Thank you Linda Flynn and Lou Cobb for creating, organizing, collecting and storing goods, and for finding low costs venues to display and sell item at. Others who have contributed to the success of the committee include: Irene Althaus, Linda, Musillami, Anne Ondraka, Barb Anderson, Andrina Lily, Marie Sundsboe,
 - Sandy Scott, Ardis Duhachek and others. The Boutique not only raises revenue for our guild, but also acquires space at many of the events for our Opportunity Quilt; has increased awareness of our guild in the community, and promoted our community involvement.
- She also thanked all members that have made and donated comfort quilts for the birth mothers at the Adoption Center of San Diego. She is delivering 8 quilts to the center next week. This will bring our total donations to the center to 12 quilts in just 6 months.

Treasurer (Barb Vajda): Our current bank balance is \$32,906. Apr. income was \$522, and Apr. expenses were \$583.

Membership (Ardis Duhachek/Diana Rash): we have 54 members, and 2 guests signed this evening. We have a total of 114 guild members.

Ardis also reminded members of the guild's history group and invited anyone interested in participating in the group to see her. For the 2017 quilt show the group is presenting a history quilt on Fallbrook. Announced tour at Historical Society on Fri., May 13th at 1pm at the Fallbrook Historical Society grounds.

Ways and Means (Sharon Baker): most of the Opportunity Quilt tickets have been picked up. Still have some new members that need to pick up their tickets. Shirley thanked Jan, Sharon and Suzy for the great job they have done this year with the Opportunity quilt.

Hospitality (Sue Burns): thanked everyone who has brought food tonight and this year. Remember that next month is our Potluck. Those whose last names start with A-Q will bring salads, and those whose names start with R-Z will bring desserts. Hospitality will provide bread.

Programs (Lou Cobb): reviewed the printed program brochure for 2016-2017. For July the program is a "Patriotic Trunk Show". She passed around a clip board for members to sign up to their patriotic quilts. Note there will be no workshop in July. October workshop — she already has 5 members signed up and only has room for 20, if you are interested in Thom Atkins workshop sign up soon. And she also has several signed up for the Feb. 2017 workshop. Extra printed programs are available if you need any to friends or family. Lou will be opening any unfilled workshops to other local guilds this next year, 2-3 weeks prior to workshop. Her goal this year is to fill the workshops.

Quilts of Love (Connie Follstad): thanks to all that brought in quilts. There are plenty of kits available, please pick up a quilt to make. Shirley read a letter earlier from Pendleton thanking the guild for the 34 Quilts of Love recently delivered.

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Call to Order: An Executive Board/Committee Chair Meeting of the F.Q.G. was held at the Quilter's Cottage, in Fallbrook CA on May 13, 2016.. The meeting was convened at 10:00 A.M. Presiding was President Shirley Fleming. Members present were Cheryl Jeter, Ardis Duhachek, Diana Rash, Sandy Scott, Lou Cobb, Christy Smith, and Jan Conklin.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer's Report (Shirley Fleming for Barbara Vajda): May income was \$462.00, expenses were \$1871.00. Current balance is \$31,688. As of July 1st we have a \$240 per meeting increase in the Community Room rental fee.

Membership (Ardis Duhachek, Diana Rash): we had 54 members at the May meeting, and 2 guests. Total membership is 114. Discussion on existing guild membership pins. Membership has been putting these in new member bags, but should they be put out for members to purchase at \$5.00. Decision was to continue to put in new member bags.

Ways and Means (Jan Conklin): Sharon and Jan took the Opportunity Quilt to the Primitive Gatherings event on April 23rd, but sold no tickets. The quilt was also scheduled to be shown at the AAUW Garden Tour on May 7th but due to rain that morning they were unable to show the quilt. There are still several members that owe for their tickets. Raffle drawing for Opportunity Quilt at the June meeting, Jan is trying to locate the barrel to put all the tickets in. Christy will put a note in the newsletter to see if anyone knows where it is. Checking with Community center also to see if they know where the barrel is.

Newsletter (Christy Smith): articles for the May newsletter need to be to Christy by May 19th. Shirley asked for an announcement about the early start time of 6:00 p.m. for the June potluck.

Turnover Meeting (Shirley Fleming): the turnover meeting for the outgoing and incoming Board and Committee Chairs will be on June 4th, at 9:30a.m., at FPUD. All board and committee chairs need to have their binders updated and ready to turn over. Dawn Johnson has the keys to FPUD and will be there early to open the room for setup. Room needs to be open by 9a.m. to setup Shirley will take care of picking up coffee and pastries.

Programs 2016-2017(Lou Cobb): will reserve FPUD for the turnover meeting for June 2017. Note: The July meeting is on the 7th, Sept. meeting is on Sept 8th, and the workshop is on Sept. 10th, please mark calendars

Workshop signups: in order to fill the workshops for 2016-2017, it was decided that all workshops will be opened to non-members to sign up at any time, there will be no restrictions. Lou will be attending the June meeting of the El Camino Quilters to present our programs for 2016-2017. Discussion of suggestion to reduce workshop fees for members. Email that Irene Althaus sent to Shirley was read and discussed. It was decided to keep workshop fees at \$35.00 for members. Diana Rash suggested a raffle for a free workshop, to be held at the discretion of the president.

Quilts of Love (Shirley Fleming): new labels will be ordered in July. Ordering woven labels at a cost of approx. \$250 for 1000.

Boutique (Lou Cobb): Lou has been unable to find out when the next Historical Society event is, when they let her know a date she and Linda Flynn will be there to sell boutique items. Lou will start requesting boutique item donations in Jan. She has decided to let members be free to make any items they want to donate, and will not be making up kits.

Friendship Committee (Shirley Fleming): for the new year Membership and Friendship committee will join together and organize a "tea" for new members. Board members will be asked to attend and explain their positions in the guild. Lou suggested the first tea be held in July, to help draw the new members to the Aug. "Quilt University" meeting.

- B) Budgets will be proposed and discussed at the July 8th board meeting.
- C) Jan gave us an update on a "Hoffman Fabrics" field trip. Has had difficulty hearing back from anyone from Hoffman, but was able to contact to right person and is expecting to hear from them today -13^{th} . Looking to arrange a bus, that can accommodate up to 47 people. Members will pay to go on the bus.
- D) While Jan was at the El Camino meeting on the 12th, she made notes on things they do to raise money for the guild and reviewed these notes with the board.
- E) Christy Smith asked if the order of the meeting could be reorganized. Suggestions were made and Shirley will look at how she can accommodate this request.


