FALLBROOK QUILT GUILD MINUTES FROM GENERAL MEETING — September 7, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 6:46 pm by Barb Vajda, President. Barb led the Pledge of Allegiance, welcomed our guests, visitors, and members. Barb reported a former guild member, Cheryl Geter, has a quilt that was accepted to the prestigious Cherrywood Fabrics Dutch Tour. Hers was one of 210 quilts chosen out of over 400 entrants. These quilts will be split with some going on the Dutch tour and the balance on the French tour. Congratulations to Cheryl!

Newsletter Deadline: The deadline for items to go in the guild newsletter is September 15th. Any items should be sent to our new newsletter editor, Diane Trappen at QuiltDLT@aol.com.

Treasurer's Report: Since Betsy Shirkey is on vacation, Barb reported our income was \$1,754.26, expenses \$1,372.40, leaving a balance of \$22,120.84.

Membership Report: Tina Rainey reported we have 57 attendees, 50 members and 7 guests. Total membership as of now is 90, including exempt members.

Hospitality: Kris Hamblen thanked everyone for bringing the refreshments tonight and says she has enough signups for the rest of the year at this time. Kris also asked the members at the meeting what kind of entertainment they would like to see at the December meeting. Some members suggested the traditional choral presentation while others thought members might enjoy just talking with each other.

Quilt Show Update: Jan Conklin says Sandy has 50 quilts for the show so far. We had over 200 at the last show. She also announced we have 60-65 quilts donated for the auction at this time but we need more and she also mentioned the items for the auction don't necessarily need to be quilts. Crafts, baskets, crocheted/knitted items, etc. are also welcome. Jan did say Betsy already has enough baby quilts for the auction. Country store/boutique items will be accepted at the October meeting.

Kris Hamblen is heading up the vendor committee at the show and needs at least 5 more vendors at this time. She has 5 signed up so far. Crafts vendors are welcome to show their wares at the vendor booth.

Sandy Scott says she still needs more volunteers to help at the quilt show and was manning a table outlining the opportunities available.

2017-2018 Opportunity Quilt: Packets of tickets are available for pickup. Reminder, each member is expected to buy at least one packet of tickets, more if you like.

2018-2019 Opportunity Quilt: Barb mentioned there are several boxes going around with fabric and a quilt block book circulating for the membership to help with the red and white quilt that will be our Opportunity Quilt for the next year. Each member is expected to make at least one quilt block during the year.

Show and Tell: Many members brought in their projects to show to the group. Barb moved Show and Tell up in the program to make sure members could see the work being done by our group.

Speaker: Sylvia Williams introduced Rita Verroca who presented "Travel Through Quilt History". Rita delighted us with anecdotes of her interest in quilting when she moved to the US and had us in stitches most of the evening with her stories. She hand pieces and quilts all of her quilts and the work she does is simply exquisite.

Drawings: The drawings were held after Rita Verroca's presentation.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:48 pm.
